



SOM YEAR 2: SYLLABUS

The Walk of Spiritual Intimacy

Students will deepen their relationship with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. They'll explore the importance of the secret place, personal worship, biblical meditation, and the lifestyle of a Kingdom leader who ministers from intimacy.

The Character of a Kingdom Leader

Students will cultivate courage, integrity, honor, humility, vulnerability, gratitude, empathy, and love. Emphasis will be placed on self-awareness and the ongoing formation of Christlike character.

TriMetrix Assessment

Students will be administered the “TriMetrix” assessment, which evaluates their DISC personality profile, internal motivators, and emotional intelligence (EQ).

Spiritual Gifts and the Gifts of the Spirit

Students will identify, develop, and activate their spiritual gifts. They will explore how to use their gifts effectively in leadership, including the importance of spiritual gifts in influencing their mountain and leading well.

Leadership Styles

Students will identify their personal leadership style and grow in understanding diverse leadership approaches. They'll learn to pursue emotional intelligence, increase self regulation, and navigate under times of stress.

Kingdom Culture

Students will emerge from the wilderness prepared to occupy God's promises and be agents of cultural transformation. They'll explore covenant authority and the foundations of Kingdom leadership.

Servant Leadership

Students will grow in servant-hearted leadership, modeled after Christ. They'll learn to create environments that nurture the physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being of those they serve—including how to lead when not in charge.

Overcoming Obstacles

Students will learn to strategically overcome challenges through emotional maturity,



transparency, calm communication, and responsibility. They will be equipped to lead through relational tension and navigate conflict resolution with Christ-likeness.

Listening from the Heart

Students will practice active listening and spiritual discernment, learning to hear both the heart of people and the guidance of the Holy Spirit in order to lead redemptively.

5-Fold Ministry

Students will explore the biblical framework of the 5-Fold Ministry (Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor, Teacher), gaining clarity on how to function within their gifts and build up the Body of Christ.

Leadership Leaves A Legacy

Students will develop a generational mindset in leadership—learning to replicate themselves, mentor others, and raise up future leaders through intentional investment and empowerment.
